Message from the Chairman

Much of our academic focus in the New Year has been on responding to NZQA on their for requirements the Master of **Business** Informatics, MBI. We have commissioned stakeholder survey to seek industry feedback on the programme and the NZQA



panel recommendations. We expect to be able to send in a revised submission in May-June, and hope to have a positive response in July-August. With numbers on our recently-approved Postgraduate Diploma in Business approaching 100, it is already our largest programme, and we expect MBI numbers to track a similarly steep climb immediately it is launched.

The MBI will have a substantial effect on our research activity, as NZQA has, not surprisingly, tasked us with more discipline-led research. So, we may expect more activity in the informatics and information security and storage areas. We are looking to recruit staff specialized in these subjects, and will be looking for doctoral-qualified, research-active candidates.

These are exciting times for ICL Graduate Business School. We thank our external stakeholders, in particular our research advisory board, to whom we will shortly be extending an invitation for the next board meeting.

The Role of Corporate Entrepreneurship and Organisational Culture on Organisational Performance

Presenter: Dr Siham El-Kafafi



Abstract

Entrepreneurship is important for organisations facing rapid change in industry, market structure, customer needs, technological advancements, and societal values. Erkkila (2000) stated that entrepreneurship draws from a wide range of skills capable of enhancement to add value to a targeted niche of human activity. On the other hand, corporate entrepreneurship is explained by Thornberry (2001) that it is viewed as acting entrepreneurially within the confines of an established organisation. Relevant to that is the organisational culture which is the set of values and beliefs behind individuals' attitudes, behaviour and performance within organisations.

J. Dahlgaard and S. Dahlgaard (1999) posited that organisational excellence can be achieved through excellent people, excellent partnerships, excellent processes, and excellent products i.e. the 4P's. For organisational excellence

to succeed, it need to be supported and driven by top management whose role is to empower and enable employees toward excellence through continuous improvement. Accordingly, leaders within organisations should be able to foster a culture of innovativeness through corporate entrepreneurship.

This study aims at determining the role of organisational culture on the development of corporate entrepreneurship and achievement of high organisational performance. Understanding organisational culture is becoming increasingly important to lead organisations towards excellence in such a highly competitive global world.

Abstract

The study here is a reflection of my (researcher's) own experience as a lecturer. I feel cultural components play an important role in my teaching and I want to explore how these components are inclusive of many cultures around me and my learners. I want to seek empirical guidelines for my ongoing thoughts around cultural components of teaching.

When inquiry touches issues intimately connected to one's life, learning becomes all important, as important as practising their art is to committed musicians, painters, or poets. Narrative curricula highlight the importance of the moment – the experience of the moment and what happens in encounters with people and things, moment by moment (Conle, 2003, p. 13).

Value of Internships for Business Students

The Research

Authors have conducted a literature survey on the topic and would like to communicate the findings to the panel and create a discussion around the topical issues that are applicable to NZ environment. The research on the topic in NZ is rather scant and needs to be brought up-to-date and to respond to the changing tertiary, business and political environment. In light of the findings by a research

committee commissioned by the NZ government, the importance of internships has once more been highlighted very clearly: the government wants relevance of degrees to the business environment, productivity of graduates to be measured and graduates made market-ready. An internship is a robust opportunity to prepare students for the business environment and business schools should ready themselves to take on this challenge.

Prospective employers have been placing an ever-increasing level of importance on their applicants' competency. Generic skills such as communication, quantitative analysis, information technology, problem solving, and ability to work with other people are required parts of most business jobs. Internships potentially provide opportunities to hone these skills as well as help develop profession-related technical skills, which is a great combination.

Research points out that internships provide students, employers, and universities with a variety of benefits. Students are evidently the most important beneficiary of internship outcomes. In view of that, to fulfil the prospective employer's requirements, business schools have been using internships as a means of providing their students with practical skills/experiences and preparing them for their future careers. The outcomes of an effective internship program, however, should not be limited to providing and/or enhancing students' skills. To face their real-life challenges, students should also possess the necessary personal/business values.
